CAMPGROUND GUIDELINES

- Checkout is at 11am. If available, late checkout is offered for a \$30 fee.
- One vehicle per campsite. All additional vehicles & trailers must be registered & parked in the parking lot.
- Trash pickup occurs UNTIL 11am.
 Trash MUST be in a bag and tied.
- Security gates are installed for your safety.
 There is a \$20 replacement fee for gate
 cards that are not returned. Lending of gate
 cards or opening the gate for others is
 grounds for immediate eviction. All vehicles
 must be registered.
- Quiet hours are from 11pm to 9am. Quiet means surrounding campsites cannot hear you. Turn radios off and refrain from talking loudly.
- Make sure your visitors are registered and aware of the visitor fee and guidelines.
 Visitors should be instructed to stop at office PRIOR to entering campground.

- Visitors need to park in the parking lot and must leave by 11am the following day.
- PLEASE DO NOT BRING FIREWOOD.
- · No area rugs on grass.
- Playgrounds close at dark. Children and teens should be at their campsite or with a parent by 10pm.
- No bicycle riding downhill or after dark.
 Stay on roads. Do not cut through campsites.
- No wheelers, golf carts, scooters, drones or RC cars allowed.
- · Speed limit is 5 mph.
- · Pets must be leashed at all times.
- Please clean up after your pets.
 Leave barking dogs at home or you and your pet will be asked to leave.

- No glass bottles, vehicles, or pets allowed on the beach or swimming area. Please be aware there is no lifeguard on duty. Swim at your own risk!
- Please respect our campground and your fellow campers. Any campers who are disrespectful to others or causes a disturbance will be asked to leave without a refund.
- Please stay within the campground boundaries and off our neighbors' property. Trespassing laws are in effect.

TUBING INFORMATION

Enjoy a 3 ½ mile float of approximately 2 hours through the beautiful Platte River Valley!

TUBING HOURS:

- WEEKDAYS: ON THE HOUR 12 3pm
- WEEKENDS: Anytime between 11 3pm

Two Rivers is proud of its reputation of being a family friendly destination. To assure this continues please follow these tubing guidelines:

- Children must be 5 years old and 42" tall.
- Tubing fee includes: tube rental, shuttle service and use of our private landing.
- You may not use your own tubes (anything that takes air). Only customers who
 have rented all tubes from Two Rivers and use our shuttle service are allowed
 to use our private landing.
- · Life jackets are recommended.
- No glass, Styrofoam or animals will be allowed on tubing trips. Please bring back all garbage.
- There is NO LIFEGUARD on duty. Safety is your responsibility. Tubing on a river is an outdoor and unpredictable experience. Tube at your own discretion. At times other restrictions may be put in place due to river conditions.
- We reserve the right to refuse service to anyone.
- *Tubing hours and availability is subject to season, weather, and river conditions
